

Riccardo Gatti (Venice, 1989) is an Italian sculptor and designer. Graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Venice, he merges the tradition of marble sculpture with a poetic and contemporary exploration of form and matter.



In 2025, he collaborated with Bulgari for the high jewelry collection 'Polychroma', creating marble and gold artworks exhibited in Taormina during the launch event. His installations accompanied the jewels in an immersive setting blending art and luxury. The collection is now part of an international tour.

Gatti has created permanent public works, including a sculpture installed in the Gardens of the Venice Biennale, and has exhibited at major international fairs such as Marmomac Verona. His work is celebrated for transforming marble into an emotional and vibrant language.



L'Écho Ultime du Rêve is a unique sculpture in white Carrara marble, entirely hand-carved.

The form evokes a sleeping figure from which fluid, symbolic waves emerge: thoughts, dreams, inner connections. The work represents the transition between wakefulness and dreaming, between matter and energy. Traditionally rigid and solid, marble here becomes a silent vibration, a sculpted breath.

A piece that invites contemplation, evoking deep feelings of suspension, intimacy, and presence.


